

SECTION 1.05 STATEMENT OF DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES - PILOT EXAMINER

Pilot Examiners are responsible to the RAAus Head of Flight Operations for the following duties and responsibilities:

1. When required by the HFO, subsequent to a CFI request, conduct ground and in-flight assessment of candidates for Certificates or endorsements and make recommendation to the HFO as to the issue or otherwise of the appropriate certificates or endorsements.
2. Conduct ground and in-flight assessment of Instructor and Senior Instructor candidates and make recommendation to the Head of Flight Operations as to the issue, or otherwise, of the appropriate ratings.
3. Conduct ground and in-flight assessment of Instructors and Senior Instructors requesting renewal of their respective ratings, and make recommendation to the Head of Flight Operations as to the renewal, or otherwise of the appropriate rating.
4. With the written approval of the Head of Flight Operations conduct ground and/or in-flight training courses for Instructor candidates.
5. Upon written request from the Head of Flight Operations, conduct ground and in-flight assessments for the issue or renewal of Deputy Chief Flying Instructor and Chief Flying Instructor, Pilot Examiner and Regional Operations Coordinator approvals, and make written recommendation as to the issue/renewal, or otherwise of the appropriate approval.
6. Upon written request from the Head of Flight Operations, conduct training and refresher courses for Deputy Chief Flying Instructors, Chief Flying Instructors, Pilot Examiners and Regional Operations Coordinators candidates for those approvals.
7. Upon request from the Head of Flight Operations, monitor the training standards and practices of specified Flight Training Schools and report, in writing, to the Head of Flight Operations.
8. Maintaining a high level of training practices and methods, overall flying standards and pilot competency under control of the RAAus.
9. At the request of the Head of Flight Operations undertake accident, incident or occurrence investigation.
